- Applicable for adjudicated and non-adjudicated males and females, including youth with low intellectual functioning.
- Tested on over 2200 youth internationally (largest validation studies in its field)
- It provides a comprehensive individualized risk assessment report according to age and gender.
- Can follow changes in the youth's risk level over time (is an outcome measure).
